Thank you for allowing us to share our viewpoint regarding HB2238.

The Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA) has oversight of eligibility for any student participating in activities sponsored by KSHSAA. The Kansas State Board of Education supports KSHSAA's authority in this and all eligibility matters relating to sponsored activities.

KSHSAA has already adopted a policy regarding transgender participation, which is available on KSHSAA's website under Policies. This policy was developed and approved by the KSHSAA Board of Directors, which includes representatives from all leagues; both public and private school representation; high school and middle school representation; governor's appointees; State Board of Education members; local board member representation; and affiliated activity organization representatives.
