Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 8-296 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-296. (a) Any person who is less than 17 years of age but is at least 14 years of age and who resides upon a farm in this state or is employed for compensation upon a farm in this state may apply to the division of vehicles for a farm permit authorizing such person, while possessing the permit, to operate any motor vehicle in class C, as designated in K.S.A. 8-234b, and amendments thereto.

- (b) (1) A farm permit shall entitle the licensee, who is at least 14 years of age, but less than 16 years of age, to operate the appropriate motor vehicles at any time:
- vehicles at any time:

 (A) While going to or from or in connection with any farm job

employment or other farm-related work;

(B) on days while school is in session, over the most direct and accessible route between the licensee's residence and school of enrollment for the purpose of school attendance; or

- (C) from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. while going directly to or from any religious activity held by a religious organization; or
- (D) when the licensee is operating a passenger car at any time when accompanied by an adult who is the holder of a valid commercial driver's license, class A, B or C driver's license and who is actually occupying a seat beside the driver.
- (2) '(A) For a period of six months, a farm permit shall entitle the licensee who is at least 16 years of age to operate the appropriate motor vehicles at any time:
- (A)(i) From 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.;

- (B)(ii) while going to or from or in connection with any farm job, employment or other farm-related work;-or
- (C)(iii) while going to or from authorized school activities:

- A farm permit shall entitle the licensee, who is at least 15 years of age, but less than 16 years of age, to operate the appropriate motor vehicles at any time:
- (A) While going to or from or in connection with any farm job employment or other farm-related work
- (B) on days while school is in session, over the most direct and accessible route between the licensee's residence and school of enrollment for the purpose of school attendance;

Any licensee issued a farm permit under this section shall provide prior to reaching 16 years of age, a signed affidavit of either a parent or guardian, stating that the applicant has completed at least 50 hours of adult supervised driving with at least 10 of those hours being at night. The adult supervised driving required by this paragraph shall be conducted by an adult who is at least 21 years of age and is the holder of a valid commercial driver's license, class A, B or C driver's license.

the 50 hours of adult supervised driving under this subsection shall not be (2) Evidence of failure of any licensee who was required to complete admissible in any action for the purpose of determining any aspect of comparative negligence or mitigation of damages.

(i) Any licensee issued a farm permit under this section who:

Is under the age of 16 years and is convicted of two or more moving traffic violations committed on separate occasions shall not be eligible to receive a driver's license-which that is not restricted in accordance with the provisions of subsection (b)(1), until the person reaches 17 years of age;

(2) is at least 16 years of age, but less than 17 years of age and is convicted of two or more moving traffic violations committed on separate occasions shall not be eligible to receive a driver's license-which that is not estricted in accordance with the provisions of subsection (b)(2), until the person reaches 18 years of age; or

provides such affidavit to the division or the person reaches 17 years of (3) fails to provide the affidavit required under subsection (h), shall not be eligible to receive a driver's license-which that is not restricted in accordance with the provisions of subsection (b)(1), until the person age, whichever occurs first.
