## Chairwoman Tyson and Committee Members:

Good morning! My name is Tom Holland and I am the State Senator for the Kansas 3<sup>rd</sup> Senate District. I am here today as a proponent conferee speaking on behalf of Senate Bill 306.

My reason for introducing SB 306 is that the Kansas Department of Revenue is unable to determine the State General Fund's possible financial exposure to Kansas Qualified Investor securities transactions being conducted on the Beneficient TEFFI at this time. This legislation would, through an addition modification provision, claw back any pass-through KAGI losses emanating from TEFFI transactions. It would not, in any way, harm the preferential tax treatment TEFFI customers would receive on their federal returns. For Kansas income tax reporting purposes, the change would be made effective retroactively back to tax year 2022.

I ask for your support of this legislation, and I would be happy to stand for questions at the appropriate time.
