Subject: House Bill No. 2498

Summary

House Bill No. 2498 provides for a new distinctive license plate – the First City of Kansas license plate. The plate would be subject to the 250 initial plate commitment and payment of up to \$5,000 in development costs as such requirements are set forth in K.S.A. 8-1,141. Initial registrations and subsequent renewals would be made through either the county treasurer or the logo use authorization statement. An annual logo use royalty payment fee in the amount of \$25 up to \$100, to be determined by the Leavenworth County Historical Society, would be required for the plates and such fees would go to the Leavenworth County Historical Society.
