
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2392 by House Committee on Veterans and Military

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2392 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2392 would update Kansas Code of Military Justice (KCMJ). The bill would make the KCMJ match the federal Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). The bill would update definitions and remove references to trial by court-martial. Language would be added to update nonjudicial punishment proceedings to match other military justice charges. The bill would also update the KCMJ punitive articles to match the UCMJ punitive articles and would continue to exclude serious felonies.

The Adjutant General's Department and the Judicial Branch state that the bill would not have a fiscal effect.
