
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 362 by Senate Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 362 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 362 would repeal the sunset date of July 1, 2024, for the Sedgwick County Urban Area Nuisance Abatement Act. The bill would make the Act permanent.

SB 362 would not have a fiscal effect on state agencies. The Kansas Association of Counties reports that the bill would not have any fiscal effect on counties, and it would allow Sedgwick County to continue to operate since the law was enacted.
