## HOUSE BILL No. 2291

1 ACT {alcoholic beverages; relating AN concerning to} food 2 establishments that are microbreweries; permitting such food 3 establishments to allow dogs in outside areas on the premises and 4 food establishments that are microbreweries to allow dogs in 5 outside and inside areas on the premises notwithstanding certain provisions of the Kansas food code; establishing conditions therefor{; 6 7 allowing beer containing not more than 6% alcohol by volume to 8 be considered cereal malt beverage and not beer under state law 9 when sold by a microbrewery}.

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11 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

12 {Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provisions of state law, any 13 beer containing not more than 6% alcohol by volume sold by the 14 individual drink by any microbrewery, as defined in K.S.A. 41-102, 15 and amendments thereto, shall be considered cereal malt beverage 16 and not beer for the purposes of:

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(a) The Kansas liquor control act; and

(b) any requirement that the sale of alcoholic liquor by the
individual drink in public places within a county be permitted when
such public places derive not less than 30% of their gross receipts
from the sale of food for consumption on the premises.}

Section 1.{Sec. 2.} (a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of state
law, a food establishment, as defined in K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 65-656, and
amendments thereto, that is a microbrewery as defined in K.S.A.-48-201
41-102, and amendments thereto, and is licensed as provided in K.S.A.-48308b 41-308b, and amendments thereto, may allow live dogs in outside
and inside areas on the premises if the conditions specified in subsection
(b) (c) are met.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provisions of state law, a food
establishment, as defined in K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 65-656, and
amendments thereto, that is not a microbrewery as defined in K.S.A.
41-102, and amendments thereto, may allow live dogs in outside areas
on the premises, if the conditions as specified in subsection (c) are met.
(b)(c) The following conditions shall be met, for both indoor and

outdoor areas as applicable, by a food establishment that is a 1

microbrewery as provided by subsection (a) for dogs to be permitted on 2 3

such food establishment's premises-pursuant to this section as permitted 4 by subsections (a) and (b):

5 (1) The food establishment shall prepare a written plan describing the 6 processes and procedures in place to prevent food contamination from 7 dogs on the premises. The plan shall be posted next to the food establishment license inside the premises of the food establishment. The 8 9 employees of the food establishment shall be trained on the plan, and the 10 plan shall be made available to the Kansas department of agriculture upon 11 request:

12 (2) dogs shall be under handler control. Dogs shall be well behaved 13 and respond to their handler's command. Dogs belonging to food establishment owners, management or employees shall not be required to 14 be leashed. Dogs belonging to guests of the food establishment shall be 15 16 leashed at all times;

17 (3) with respect to a food establishment that is a microbrewery, as 18 provided by subsection (a), dogs in indoor areas shall not be permitted in 19 food or drink preparation areas, including, but not limited to, kitchens and 20 behind bars:

21 (4) dogs shall not be permitted on dining surfaces, including tables, 22 bars or counter tops;

23 (5) dogs shall not be fed or watered from any food establishment 24 equipment, including, but not limited to, plates, bowls and utensils, except 25 for single-service items that are disposed of immediately following such 26 use:

27 (6) an area outside the food establishment shall be designated for dog 28 urination and defecation;

29 (7) employees shall be required to wash their hands after contact of 30 any kind with a dog prior to handling any food, drink, utensil or food or 31 drink production, preparation or serving equipment or the preparation or 32 use of surfaces that may come into contact with food or drink;

33 (8) guests shall be advised to wash their hands after any contact with 34 a dog; and

35 (9) a process for immediately sanitizing equipment or surfaces used 36 for the production, preparation, serving or consumption of food or drink if 37 a dog has contact with such equipment or surfaces shall be developed and 38 followed by the food establishment. This process shall include instructions 39 for disposing of contaminated food or drink.
