1 AN ACT concerning employment; restoring local government control over
2 wages, compensation and benefits for construction projects; amending
3 K.S.A. 12-16,132 and 2022 Supp. 19-26,114 and repealing the existing
4 sections; also repealing K.S.A. 12-16,131.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 12-16,132 is hereby amended to read as follows:
8 12-16,132. The administration, enactment or enforcement of any city
9 ordinance ~~which~~ that conflicts with K.S.A. 12-16,130 ~~or 12-16,131~~, and
10 amendments thereto, is hereby declared to be void and against the public
11 policy of this state.

12 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 19-26,114 is hereby amended to read as
13 follows: 19-26,114. The administration, enactment or enforcement of any
14 county resolution ~~which~~ that conflicts with K.S.A. 12-16,130 ~~or 12-~~
15 ~~16,131~~, and amendments thereto, is hereby declared to be void and against
16 the public policy of this state.

17 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 12-16,131 and 12-16,132 and K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 19-
18 26,114 are hereby repealed.

19 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
20 publication in the statute book.
