

House Concurrent Resolution No. 5027

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION extending the 2024 regular session of
2 the Legislature beyond 90 calendar days; providing for the
3 adjournment of the Senate and the House of Representatives.
4

5 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, the
6 Senate concurring therein: That the 2024 regular session of the
7 Legislature shall be extended beyond 90 calendar days; and

8 *Be it further resolved:* That the Legislature shall adjourn at the close of
9 business of the daily session convened on April 5, 2024, and shall
10 reconvene on April 25, 2024; and

11 *Be it further resolved:* That the Legislature may adjourn and reconvene at
12 any time during the period on and after April 25, 2024, through April
13 30, 2024, but the Legislature shall reconvene on April 30, 2024, at
14 which time the Legislature shall continue in session and adjourn sine
15 die at the close of business of the daily session convened on April 30,
16 2024; and

17 *Be it further resolved:* That the chief clerk of the house of representatives
18 and the secretary of the senate and employees specified by the director
19 of legislative administrative services for such purpose shall attend to
20 their duties each day during periods of adjournment, Sundays
21 excepted, for the purpose of receiving messages from the governor
22 and conducting such other business as may be required; and

23 *Be it further resolved:* That members of the Legislature shall not receive
24 the per diem compensation and subsistence allowances provided for in
25 K.S.A. 46-137a(a) and (b), and amendments thereto, for any day
26 within a period in which both houses of the Legislature are adjourned
27 for more than two days, Sundays excepted; and

28 *Be it further resolved:* That members of the Legislature attending a
29 legislative meeting of whatever nature when authorized pursuant to
30 law, or by the legislative coordinating council, the president of the
31 senate or the speaker of the house of representatives, and members of
32 a conference committee attending a meeting of the conference
33 committee authorized by the president of the senate and the speaker of
34 the house of representatives during any period of adjournment for
35 which members are not authorized compensation and allowances
36 pursuant to K.S.A. 46-137a, and amendments thereto, shall receive

1 compensation, subsistence allowances, mileage and other expenses in
2 amounts prescribed under K.S.A. 75-3212, and amendments thereto.
