1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to license plates; requiring  
2 certain license plates to have the county of registration for the motor  
3 vehicle identified on the plate.  
4

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. **(a)** On and after January 1, 2024, license plates furnished  
7 for a motor vehicle and issued by the division of vehicles shall have  
8 designated the county of registration for such motor vehicle. The director  
9 of vehicles may either print the abbreviation of the county of registration  
10 directly on the license plate or affix to the license plate by a decal the  
11 abbreviation of the county of registration. ***Except as otherwise provided in***  
12 ***subsection (b)***, The provisions of this section shall apply to:

13 **(a)(1)** Any passenger vehicle or truck as defined in K.S.A. 8-126, and  
14 amendments thereto, that is subject to taxation pursuant to K.S.A. 79-5101  
15 et seq., and amendments thereto; or

16 **(b)(2)** any vehicle that displays a distinctive or personalized license  
17 plate.

18 **(b)** *The provisions of this section shall not apply to distinctive*  
19 *license plates designating a person as a recipient of the congressional*  
20 *medal of honor issued pursuant to K.S.A. 8-1,145, and amendments*  
21 *thereto.*

22 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
23 publication in the statute book.
