AN ACT concerning education; relating to school districts and employees
thereof; requiring parental consent for use of a student's pronouns;
prohibiting schools from requiring use of an individual's pronouns over
moral or religious objections; requiring school districts to adopt
policies thereon.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

8 Section 1. (a) An employee or independent contractor of a school 9 district shall not knowingly address, identify or refer to a student who is 10 less than 18 years of age by a pronoun that differs from the pronoun that 11 aligns with the student's biological sex unless the school district has 12 received written permission from the student's parent or guardian.

(b) A school district shall not require an employee or independent contractor of such school district to address, identify or refer to an individual by a pronoun that differs from the pronoun that aligns with the student's biological sex if doing so is contrary to the employee's or independent contractor's moral or religious convictions.

(c) The school board of each school district shall adopt a policy toimplement this section.

(d) This section shall not be construed to prohibit any employee or
independent contractor of a school district from discussing matters of
public concern outside such employee's or independent contractor's official
duties.
