AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates; 2 providing for the city of Topeka license plate.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2024, any owner or lessee of 5 6 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 7 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with 8 the provisions of this section, may be issued one city of Topeka license 9 plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be 10 issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper registration 11 and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and 12 amendments thereto, and payment to the county treasurer of the flag image 13 payment provided for in subsection (b).

14 (b) Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may apply annually to use the city of Topeka flag image on a license plate as provided for in this section. 15 Such owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not less than \$25 but not 16 more than \$100 for each such license plate to be issued. The flag image 17 18 payment shall be paid to the county treasurer.

19 Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may (c) 20 make application for such license plate, not less than 60 days prior to such 21 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished 22 by the director of vehicles. Any applicant for such license plate shall pay 23 to the county treasurer the flag image payment. Application for registration 24 of a passenger vehicle or truck and the issuance of the license plate under 25 this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed 26 by the director of vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

27 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be 28 transferable to any other person.

29 The director of vehicles may transfer a city of Topeka license (e) 30 plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

31 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually, 32 upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments 33 thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments 34 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until 35 such applicant provides to the county treasurer the flag image payment. If 36 the annual flag image payment is not provided to the county treasurer, the applicant shall be required to comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-143,
 and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county
 treasurer of such person's residence.

4 (g) The city of Topeka flag image referred to in subsection (b) was 35 adopted by the city of Topeka governing body on November 12, 2019. The 46 flag was designed through a community input process managed by the 47 greater Topeka partnership, inc. No individual or entity claims intellectual 48 property rights to the city of Topeka flag image. Use of the city of Topeka 49 flag image to be displayed on a license plate shall be designed with the 40 approval of the director of vehicles.

(h) As a condition of receiving the city of Topeka license plate and
any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the applicant
shall consent to the division authorizing the division's release of motor
vehicle record information, including the applicant's name, address, flag
image payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to the city of
Topeka and the state treasurer.

(i) The collection and remittance of annual flag image payments by
the county treasurer shall be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 81,141(h), and amendments thereto, except that payments from the city of
Topeka flag image fund shall be made on a monthly basis to the greater
Topeka partnership, inc. A change of the city's designee shall occur only
by mutual agreement by the city of Topeka and the greater Topeka
partnership, inc.
