AN ACT concerning the Kansas silver alert plan; relating to public notice
 of certain missing persons; expanding such plan to include persons 18
 years of age or older who have an intellectual disability; amending
 K.S.A. 75-754 and repealing the existing section.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 75-754 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-8 754. (*a*) There is hereby established the Kansas silver alert plan. The 9 Kansas silver alert plan shall be established and implemented by the office 10 of attorney general, in collaboration with the Kansas bureau of 11 investigation, Kansas highway patrol, local law enforcement agencies and 12 other public and private agencies and organizations.

(b) Under the Kansas silver alert plan, public notice of a missing
elderly person or a missing person who is 18 years of age or older and
who has an intellectual disability may be promptly broadcast and a search
may be timely undertaken with the cooperation of local law enforcement,
news media and the general public in order to locate such person in time to
avoid serious harm or death.
