Sec. 65. If any fund or account name described by words and the numerical accounting code that follows such fund or account name do not match, it shall be conclusively presumed that the legislature intended that the fund or account name described by words is the correct fund or account name, and such fund or account name described by words shall control over a contradictory or incorrect numerical accounting code.

10 Sec. 66. *Appeals to exceed expenditure limitations*. Upon written 11 application to the governor and approval of the state finance council, 12 expenditures from special revenue funds may exceed the amounts 13 specified in this act.

14 Sec. 67. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 15 publication in the Kansas register.
