AN ACT creating the protection against deep fakes act; establishing a 1 2 cause of action for damages arising from the use of generative artificial intelligence to create an image or likeness of another person for use in 3 obscene material without such person's consent. 4 5 6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 7 Section 1. (a) Any person whose image or likeness is used or depicted by synthetic media in published obscene material without such person 8 having expressly consented in writing to such use or depiction may bring 9 10 an action in an appropriate state court against the producer, promoter or 11 intentional possessor of such obscene material. 12 (b) In any action brought under this section, the prevailing plaintiff 13 shall recover: 14 (1) Actual damages; 15 (2) punitive damages in an amount equal to the total amount of revenue received by the defendant related to the publication of the obscene 16 17 material: and 18 (3) reasonable attorney fees and court costs. 19 (c) It shall be an affirmative defense to any action brought under this 20 section that the plaintiff expressly consented in writing to the use or 21 depiction of such plaintiff's image or likeness as specifically used in the 22 published obscene material. 23 (d) It shall not be a defense to any action brought under this section 24 that the image or likeness of the plaintiff used or depicted in the published 25 obscene material is generated using artificial intelligence and is not the 26 actual image or likeness of the plaintiff. 27 (e) As used in this section: 28 (1) "Obscene" and "material" mean the same as defined in K.S.A. 21-29 6401, and amendments thereto; 30 "publish" means to make available to one or more persons for (2)31 viewing, listening or other method of consuming such material regardless 32 of whether for profit or free of charge; and 33 "synthetic media" means an image, an audio recording or a video (3) 34 recording of an individual's appearance, speech or conduct that has been 35 intentionally manipulated with the use of generative artificial intelligence 36 techniques or other digital technology in a manner that creates a realistic

1 but false or inaccurate image, audio or video that produces:

2 (A) A depiction that, to a reasonable individual, is of a real individual 3 in appearance, action or speech but that did not actually occur in reality; 4 and

5 (B) a fundamentally different understanding or impression of the 6 appearance, action or speech than a reasonable person would otherwise 7 have from the unaltered, original version of the image, audio recording or 8 video recording.

9 (f) This section shall be known and may be cited as the protection 10 against deep fakes act.

11 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 12 publication in the statute book.
